Payment

A non-refundable deposit of \$1500.00 (\$1500.00 or \$1000.00) and a one New Registration Fee of \$500.00 must be paid upon acceptance into our program. The balance of all fees are due in 3 instalments through-out the year. September 1st, 2011, December 1st, 2011 and March 1st, 2012. Monthly instalments may be arranged.

Additional Fees

If families opt to have our Psychologist meet with their child at the centre, an additional fee of \$175.00 will be added. Our Psychologist offers assessments, support and consultations to our children upon the parent's request. Fees are billed separately.

Upon registering for our Academy Program, it is the parent's responsibility for a full year tuition. The Parent(s) or Guardian of the child agree and are liable for the full tuition and charges owing to our Academy with respect to the enrolment of the Child. Fees are due upon registering and payment will be due on or before the day of Registration Agreement. If a family chooses to leave the school for any reason during the school year, the deposit and payments are not reimbursed to the family.
